Listed by UNESCO as a World Cultural Heritage Site in 1987, it is now one of the most popular tourist attractions worldwide.

# 2) Chinese Acrobatic Show with Beijing Noodle Dinner-USD\$29/per person

When we consider Beijing style dishes, most people will think of Beijing Duck. But there is another delicious traditional Beijing style dish – Noodles with Soy Bean Paste. 
