In the morning, visit the famous Great Wall of China. You will visit the Juyongguan Pass of the Wall, one of the three famous passes, was a solid stronghold encircling a valley. The Wall was listed as a World UNESCO Heritage site in 1987. Later, head to the Olympic Park where the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games took place. The park was designed to contact ten venues, the Olympic Village, and other supporting facilities. See the Bird's Nest, the National Stadium, which is situated in Olympic Green Village. Transfer back to the hotel and the remaining of the day will be yours to enjoy or opt for an optional tour. Dinner is not included.

After, visit the Forbidden City, once served as the imperial palace for 24 emperors during the Ming & Qing Dynasties. Now known as the Palace Museum, it is the world's largest palace complex and covers 74 hectares. Listed by UNESCO as a World Cultural Heritage Site in 1987, it is now one of the most popular tourist attractions worldwide.

2) Chinese Acrobatic Show with Beijing Noodle Dinner-USD\$29/per person

When we consider Beijing style dishes, most people will think of Beijing Duck. But there is another delicious traditional Beijing style dish – Noodles with Soy Bean Paste. Tonight, enjoy an authentic Beijing Noodle with Soy Bean Paste. Zha Jiang Mian, or "Fried Sauce Noodles". So famous in China that the mere mention of it immediately makes people think of Beijing. After dinner, watch an acrobatic show that is being performed by highly-trained circus performers. It is action packed with outstanding feats, beautiful choreography, color, and excitement. Day 4 Beijing > Xi'an

In the morning, transfer to the airport for your flight to Xian. Upon arrival, visit the Big Wild Goose Pagoda, a well-preserved ancient building and a holy place for Buddhists. It attracts numerous visitors for its fame in the Buddhist religion and its simple but appealing style









of construction. Big Wild Goose Pagoda is rated as a National Key Cultural Relic Preserve as well as an AAAA Tourist Attraction. In the afternoon, pass by the Bell Tower and visit the Ancient City Wall, the most complete city wall that has survived in China, as well being one of the largest ancient military defensive systems in the world. Dinner is not included.

Tang Dynasty Show with Dumpling Banquet -USD\$59pp

Immerse yourself in the cultural and culinary delights of Xi'an during a Tang Dynasty Show and Dumpling Banquet. In the morning, visit the famous Terra Cotta Warrior Museum. It is a super large collection of life-size terra cotta sculptures in battle formations, reproducing the mega imperial guard troops of Emperor Qin Shi Huang, the first emperor of the first unified dynasty of Imperial China. Being the most significant archeological excavations of the 20th century and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Terracotta Army is no doubt a mustsee for every visitor to Xian. In the afternoon, visit the Shaanxi History Museum, regarded as 'the pearl of ancient dynasties and house of Chinese treasures', gives a miniature overview of the thousands of years of Chinese history and the splendid ancient cultures of olden times. Day 6 Xi'an → Nanjing

After breakfast, take a flight to Nanjing, where its history, nature and modernization can be witnessed in one glance. On arrival, visit the Taicheng Wall, one of the key historical and cultural remains of Ming Dynasty under state protection that demonstrates China's ancient architecture. Even though it has a history of 600 years, it is still a spectacular sight due its preservation. Afterward, visit the Confucius Temple, dedicated to worshipping China's most influential philosopher, Confucius.

The Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal

Originally, the temple was constructed in the year of 1034 in the Song Dynasty (420-589). It suffered repeated damage and has been rebuilt on several occasions since that time. After dinner, board on to the cruise. Join the welcome party with the captain and the crew. Enjoy the night view of Nanjing. (Lunch is on your own expenses or on the plane)

Day 7 Yangtze River Cruise - Yangzhou (B/L/D)

Walking along the Pingjiang road, you can see all the scenery was as beautiful as a painting. Later, visit Hanshan Temple. Being one of the most famous temples in Chinese history, Hanshan Temple often boasts about its bell

rings. It is also a Buddhism temple. The statue of the Buddhist patriarch Sakyamuni is there for people to make offerings to in the Grand Prayer Hall. Until now, the temple is one of the most important places to hold Buddhism activities. Return back to the boat after
